**MEASURE'S PURPOSE:** The measure reorganizes the Workers' Compensation Nominating Commission and confirms Executive Order 2016-319.

**PROVISIONS/MECHANICS:** Section 1 amends KRS 342.213 to abolish the Workers' Compensation Nominating Commission and creates the Workers' Compensation Nominating Committee. It establishes the number of committee members, the qualifications for members, and responsibilities for members.

Sections 2 through 5 amend various statutes to conform.

Section 6 authorizes any member of the committee who previously served on the Workers' Compensation Nominating Commission prior to May 9, 2016, and who was appointed to the committee pursuant to Executive Order 2016-319 to be paid at the rate of \$100 per day for each meeting they attend for the duration of their term.

Section 7 confirms Executive Order 2016-319, dated June 13, 2016.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** The measure contains the same provisions as Executive Order 2016-319, therefore there is no fiscal impact.
