Part II: Purpose and Mechanics

If HB 353 is enacted and in like manner concurred in by the 2019 General Assembly, then County clerks will be required to place the question to voters in every precinct during the next regular election held for state officers or members of the House of Representatives which occurs no less than ninety days from the final passage of the Act.

Part III: Fiscal Explanation, Bill Provisions, and Estimated Cost

The fiscal impact of HB 353 is minimal. As the question is to be voted on during a regular election, there will be no costs other than the embedded time and effort costs associated with the ballot wording and recording of votes.
