Part II: Purpose and Mechanics

HB 465 **Section 1** would create a new section of KRS Chapter 164 to establish the Kentucky Community and Technical College System special license plate student scholarship fund. The fund would be used to pay for costs or fees incurred in its administration and for distribution of scholarships. **Section 2** of the bill would amend KRS 186.162 to establish an initial fee for the special license plate of \$50 and a renewal fee of \$25. Three (\$3) dollars of each fee would be dedicated to the use of the county clerk. **Section 3** of the bill would amend KRS 186.166 to direct the Transportation Cabinet to perpetually produce community and technical college system license plates.

Part III: Fiscal Explanation, Bill Provisions, and Estimated Cost

HB 465 would have no to minimal fiscal impact on county clerks' offices.

The fees for issuance and renewal of the community and technical college system license plates would be paid to the issuing clerk who would retain \$3.00 of each fee for use of the county clerk's office. HB 465 would result in no net increase or decrease in the fees received by county clerks, since the clerk retains the same amount of fees for issuance and renewal of the special plate as it does for a regular license plate.
