<u>MEASURE'S PURPOSE</u>: The measure provides supplemental funds to the Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE) in order to fully fund 164 veterinary medicine and 44 optometry slots in the Contract Spaces Program.

PROVISIONS/MECHANICS: Section 1 appropriates funds in the amount of \$196,100 in fiscal year 2016-2017 and \$298,000 in fiscal year 2017-2018.

Section 2 declares an emergency and states that the bill will take effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming law.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The fiscal impact of this measure is a total of \$494,100 in General Fund dollars over the 2016-18 biennium consisting of \$196,100 in fiscal year 2016-17 and \$298,000 in fiscal year 2017-2018 to fully fund 164 veterinary medicine and 44 optometry slots in the Contract Spaces Program.
