MEASURE'S PURPOSE: The purpose of the measure is to require the Department of Military Affairs to promulgate administrative regulations related to the administration of death in the line of duty benefits for National Guard or Reserve component members.

PROVISIONS/MECHANICS: Section 1 amends KRS 61.315 to require the Department of Military Affairs to promulgate administrative regulations related to death in the line of duty benefits for National Guard or Reserve component members, including establishing the conditions that constitute death in the line of duty.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: Mandating the Department of Military Affairs to promulgate administrative regulations relating to death in the line of duty benefits for National Guard or Reserve component members will not have a fiscal impact. Current statutes do not allow the Department to promulgate regulations. Therefore, there is no set policy for defining death in the line of duty benefits. However, the administrative regulations once promulgated could have an impact on the General Fund if they differ from existing practice.
