**MEASURE'S PURPOSE:** To provide more flexibility to the Kentucky Grape and Wine Council for the use of the Small Farm Wineries Support fund, to establish a Vineyard Expansion Reimbursement Grant Program, and to replace references to the Grape and Wine Council fund with the Small Farm Wineries Support fund.

**PROVISIONS/MECHANICS:** Section 1 amends KRS 260.165 to replace a reference to the Grape and Wine Council fund with the Small Farm Wineries Support fund.

Section 2 amends KRS 260.166 to replace a reference to the Grape and Wine Council fund with the Small Farm Wineries Support fund.

Section 3 amends KRS 260.167 to replace a reference to the Grape and Wine Council fund with the Small Farm Wineries Support fund.

Section 4 amends KRS 260.175 to eliminate the dollar amounts for the required programmatic expenses. The section requires the Kentucky Grape and Wine Council to establish a Vineyard

Expansion Reimbursement Grant Program to expand or improve existing vineyards. The section also requires the Kentucky Grape and Wine Council to report annual revenues and expenditures to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue and the Interim Joint Committee on Agriculture. Lastly, the section replaces a reference to the Grape and Wine Council fund with the Small Farm Wineries Support fund.

Section 5 repeals KRS 260.168 to abolish the Kentucky Grape and Wine Council fund.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** HB 119 would have no fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The Kentucky Grape and Wine Council would continue to receive \$400,000 via the Small Farm Winery Support fund for the Kentucky Grape and Wine Council's required programs. Instead of \$400,000 being divided among four required programs under current law, the bill would divide the \$400,000 among five required programs.
