MEASURE'S PURPOSE: The measure requires schools to purchase automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) as funds become available, adopt policies and procedures for their use, and ensure that employees are trained in their use.

PROVISIONS/MECHANICS: Section 1 amends KRS 158.162 to require schools to purchase AEDs as funds become available. It also requires the schools to adopt procedures for AED use during an emergency as well as policies and procedures necessary for their use at school events outside the normal school day. The policies and procedures would comply with existing state law on AED use, and the schools would have to ensure that at least three employees are trained in their use.

Section 2 amends KRS 158.302 to delete language that conflicts with Section 1.

Section 3 allows the legislation to be cited as "Cameron's Law."

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The legislation requires local schools to purchase AEDs as funds become available, and does not affect state funds that flow to local school districts. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact.
