Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 310 GA provides that city clerks may mail or **electronically** submit required personnel information to the state Department for Local Government. The Act requires that telephone numbers, electronic mail addresses, correct names, for the following employee categories be provided to the Department for Local Government:

- City clerk
- City treasurer or chief financial officer
- City manager or administrator
- City attorney
- Human resources director
- Police chief
- Fire chief

- Public works director
- Risk manager
- Information technology manager
- Public relations or communications officer
- Planning and zoning administrator

The fiscal impact of HB 310 GA will be nil to minimal. Some indeterminate time and effort will be required to provide (to the Department for Local government) the additional personnel information required by the Act. Providing the required information electronically will have a very minimal positive impact.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

The GA version to this bill does not have any changes from the bill as introduced. There were no committee substitutes or floor amendments adopted.
