



New personalized plates issued after the effective date of this Act, will expire on the last day of the birth month of the applicant.

All personalized license plates will be replaced on the same schedule as regular license plates unless it is damaged or unreadable.

Fee collection and allocation will not change as a result of this bill.

Implementation of HB 530 will have a negligible fiscal impact on county clerks offices. The effect of this bill will be to spread license plate renewals over the calendar year as opposed to lumping all of the personalized plates at the end of the year.

**Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions**

HB 530 GA incorporates HFA 1, pro rata language establishing that the registration fee shall be based on the number of months the registration is valid in the year 2019. HFA 1 also deletes new language from the bill as introduced that stipulated the personalized plate must be renewed 30 days prior to the date of expiration. **There is no effect on the original LM for HB 530.**
