## Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

SB 82 would create 3 new sections of KRS Chapter 109, Local Solid Waste Management. **Section 1** would establish a definition for the terms "auxiliary container" and "local government." **Section 2** would prohibit **any** local government or special purpose entity from adopting any ordinance, rule, etc. that regulates the use, disposition, or sale of auxiliary containers, that prohibits or restricts auxiliary containers, or that imposes a fee, charge, or tax on auxiliary containers. **Section 3** would establish that the Act does not prohibit recycling nor prohibit ordinances that prohibit littering.

SB 82 would have no or minimal fiscal impact on local governments.
