Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

SB 88 GA provides that the General Assembly shall not impose requirements on cities of any class that require city expenditures or tax levies unless the requirements are fully funded by the General Assembly or the requirements are approved by the city's legislative body.

The above shall not apply if the requirements are the result of a federal mandate and in no case shall these requirements extend beyond the requirements of a federal mandate.

Nothing in SB 88 GA shall affect the requirements related to fiscal notes prepared for a bill or resolution relating to local government, the County Employees Retirement System, or any other retirement system or plan established by Kentucky law.

The fiscal impact of SB 88 GA is indeterminable. Impact would be subject to future legislation.

Whereas the General Assembly would have to fund any mandates it places on a local government, this might result in fewer mandates or more money going to local governments in the future.

The Kentucky League of Cities supports this proposal.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

The LM statement to SB 88 GA is the same as the LM statement to SB 88 as introduced except for the inclusion of a Senate Floor Amendment which ensures that nothing in this section shall affect the County Employees Retirement System, or any other retirement system or plan established by Kentucky law.
