Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 222 amends KRS 224.43-310 to require that Energy and Environment Cabinet (EEC) make “quarterly solid waste action reports” to each solid waste coordinator of a solid waste management area (to cover complaints, investigations, and actions). It requires enforcement officers to submit a copy of the report to the county fiscal court of every county located in the solid waste management area. The Act amends KRS 224.43-340 to require the promulgation of administrative regulations regarding the issuance of a quarterly solid waste action report to solid waste coordinators.

The fiscal impact of HB 222 is minimal. Local solid waste coordinators will be responsible for receiving and forwarding EEC reports to the counties within the coordinators’ solid waste management districts. There may be time and effort requirements related to responding to information contained in the reports.
