

117.245. HB 363 requires the county clerk to provide a report to the State Board of Elections of the number of voters registering to vote at precincts on Election Day.

Regarding primary elections. HB 363 deletes the requirement that in order to vote, a person must have been registered as a member of the political party by December 31 or, in the case of new registrations, have been registered and remained registered as a member of that party. HB 363 amends KRS 117.225 to provide that if the person is not listed on the precinct roster, the person must be given the opportunity to register and vote at the precinct on the day of an election and amends KRS 117.365 to **require applications for voter registration at the precinct to be presented (by the county clerk) to the grand jury and retained by the county clerk.**
