Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

SB 66 would establish a new section of KRS Chapter 186 to create the Colon Cancer Prevention special license plate. The plate would be obtained on application and payment of the fee to the county clerk of the county of the applicant's residence. Section 3 of the bill would establish an initial fee of \$40 for issuance of the plate and a fee of \$30 to renew the plate.

SB 66 would have no to minimal fiscal impact on county clerks' offices. The fees for issuance and renewal of the Colon Cancer Prevention special license plate would be paid to the issuing clerk who would retain \$3.00 of each fee for use of the county clerk's office. SB 66 would result in no net increase or decrease in the fees received by county clerks, since the clerk retains the same amount of fees for issuance and renewal of the special plate as it does for a regular license plate.
