**Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions**

SB 70 GA retains all provisions of SB 70 SCS, and the fiscal impact to local governments is identical to SB 70 SCS and SB 70 as introduced.

SB 70 SCS retains the original provisions of SB 70 but changes the word “knowingly” to “wantonly” in Subsection (1) of Section 1 of the bill. SB 70 SCS expands the definition of strangulation from the version as introduced. **The fiscal impact of SB 70 SCS remains identical to that of SB 70 as introduced.**
