HB 158 amends KRS 438.305 to include definitions for "flavored vapor product" and 'characterizing flavor". It creates a new section of KRS 438.305 to 438.340 to ban the sale, purchase, and distribution of flavored vapor products in the Commonwealth, including online transactions, and establishes fines for violations.
<b>The impact of HB 158 will be minimal.</b> Local peace officers will be required to enforce the provisions of the bill, and may issue uniform citations.
