Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government
HB 592 amends KRS 61.522 to move the one-time window when quasi-governmental agencies may voluntarily cease participation in the Kentucky Employees Retirement System (KERS) ahead one year from June 30, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and to move all other corresponding timelines for the window ahead one year.
The fiscal impact of HB 592 on local governments is not known at this time. The Kentucky Retirements Systems has not completed an actuarial analysis for HB 592. If, and when, the statement is available, the LM will be updated accordingly.
