**<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>**: The measure adds wastewater services as a custodial duty of the fiscal court, and authorizes the court to collect property taxes necessary to maintain wastewater services for court offices.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** There is no fiscal impact to state government. All revenue and expenditure impacts under the measure would fall to the fiscal court, and are outside the scope of this fiscal note.
