PURPOSE OF MEASURE: The purpose of the measure is to prohibit the certification or renewal of an assisted-living community, if it is owned or operated by a person convicted of certain crimes or is listed on an abuse registry, and to make changes to the appeals and renewal process.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) will utilize existing systems to track felony offense listings, child and adult abuse and neglect listings, and the Kentucky Nurse Aide Abuse Registry listings for any convictions of a manager, owner, or operator of an assisted-living community. Because the tracking system infrastructure already exists, there will be no fiscal impact to the CHFS.
