Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

This bill request excludes disaster response businesses and disaster response employees from being assessed occupational license tax and license fees in the event they come into Kentucky for the purpose of doing emergency-related work during a disaster response period. A disaster response business and disaster response employee means an entity or individual who has no presence, work, or resides within the state, except for disaster or emergency-related work during a disaster response period.

A disaster response period is defined as beginning 10 days prior to the first day of the Governor's declaration or the President's declaration whichever occurs first and that extends 30 calendar days after the declared state disaster or emergency.

The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminable. It cannot be forecasted when or the frequency in which a declaration of disaster may occur and if so, the impact on cities and

counties in Kentucky. It is also not possible to predict if or when a need will exist for outof-state disaster response businesses and employees.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

Part II, above, pertains to the GA version. The GA version is the same as the bill as introduced. No amendments or substitutes were adopted when the bill passed its chamber of origin.
