## Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 2 GA would re-assign numerous counties from their current House district to a different district. Since there are primary and general elections scheduled to occur in 2022, an emergency is declared and the bill will be effective on its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming law.

**The fiscal impact of HB 2 GA on local governments is indeterminable** but could be significant if the proposal splits precincts requiring voting machines to be reprogrammed and registration books to be updated. If the precincts are kept intact, then cost should be minimal.

## Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

HB 2 GA keeps the provision of HB 2 as introduced and amended by HCS 1.

HB 2 HCS 1 makes changes to HB 2 regarding the redistribution of precincts between districts.
