Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 404 provides that the Department of Workplace Standards shall provide employers, employees, and the general public with information with respect to rendering first aid to individuals experiencing a seizure. This information shall be disseminated through exhibitions, broadcast, lectures, posters, flyers, pamphlets, or any other method available to the employer. All employers shall post this information in a prominent place in the employer's workplace.

The fiscal impact of HB 404 to local governments is expected to be minimal. HB 404 provides that the Department of Workplace Standards shall provide information, but is not clear if this is information ready to be posted and disseminated or if it is information the local government can use to produce materials for posting and dissemination. If the information provided is suitable for public/employee circulation, then the cost should be minimal, and entail only the employee time necessary to disseminate.

If the information received is not readily available for dissemination, then the local government will need to have material printed (posters, flyers, pamphlets, etc.) depending how they opt to disseminate. Lectures could be stand alone or incorporated into other training already provided by the local government to its employees.

The following are cost estimates from Office Depot for copy services:

- Full color, letter size, 100 copies for .52 per copy; 500 for .48 per copy; 1,000 for .44 per copy;
- For black and white, letter size, 250 copies for .16 per copy; 750 copies for .14 per copy; 1500 for .13 per copy.
- Full color Posters 16" X 20", starting at \$13.99; 18" X 24" starting at \$15.99

Larger cities may have the ability to handle the quantity and type of printing desired inhouse. If so the cost would be less.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

Part II refers to HB 404 GA version. The GA version is the same as the bill introduced. HB 404 passed its chamber of origin without any amendments or substitutes.
