Ms. Carney:

House Bill 638 (2022 RS BR 2086) amends KRS 61.675 to make a technical change regarding employer reporting and compliance with KRS 16.505 to 16.652, 61.610 to 61.705, or 78.510 to 78.852

Kentucky Public Pensions Authority (KPPA) staff members reviewed House Bill 638 (2022 RS BR 2086). We have determined that the bill will not increase or decrease benefits or the participation in benefits in any of the retirement systems administered by KPPA.

In accordance with KRS 6.350(2)(c), Kentucky Public Pensions Authority certifies the following:

- 1. The estimated number of individuals affected as of June 30, 2021 are 123,809 active members, 155,506 inactive members and 121,728 retired members in the systems operated by KPPA;
- 2. There is no estimated change in benefit payments;
- 3. There is no estimated change in employer expenses;
- 4. There is not estimated change in administrative expenses.

We have not requested any further actuarial analysis of House Bill 638 (2022 RS BR 2086) by the Authority's independent actuary.
