PURPOSE OF MEASURE: The measure amends the eligible expenditures of the West Kentucky State Aid Funding for Emergencies (SAFE) Fund to support disaster and recovery relief only to the extent of the damage directly caused by the storms and to remove as an eligible expense assistance to utilities serving affected counties for resilient response and future risk reduction. The measure also expands the reporting requirements of the Office of State Budget Director and the Department of Education.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The measure appropriates \$75,000,000 in fiscal year 2021-2022 from the SAFE Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for the reimbursement of eligible expenditures according to the established criteria.
