

- Be insured by the owner or operator in the same form and amounts as set for motorcycles in KRS 304.39-110, with proof of insurance kept in the vehicle.

KRS 186A.070, 189.515, and 189.990, and are amended to conform.

SB 221 repeals KRS 189.281, which created a local government pilot program for off-highway vehicles. It also sets the effective date of this Act as January 1, 2023.

The fiscal impact of SB 221 is indeterminable but expected to be minimally positive. Currently, registration and titling of OHV's is not required to operate an OHV on Kentucky roadways under the pilot program. No estimate on the potential number of OHV that could be inspected, titled, and registered is available. County clerks will receive \$6 for each registration, and sheriffs' offices will receive a \$5 fee upon completion of the required inspection certification.
