

jail, and he or she shall be transported to the court that issued the warrant within 10 days by an officer of the county where the warrant was issued. If this 10 day deadline isn't met, then the jail of the county where the warrant was issued shall provide for the costs of incarceration of the person.

Section 2 provides requirements for units of government to be eligible for funds from the Law Enforcement Foundation Program fund. **Section 2** amends KRS 15.440 to require the unit to have written policy and procedures manual related to serving and returning warrants. These policies and procedures must have minimum standards for officers in the service and return of warrants; a requirement that all warrants served by officers be returned to the court that issued the warrant within 72 hours of execution; and a requirement that officers who fail to return executed warrants within the required 72 hours be subject to discipline, up to termination. **Section 3** amends KRS 15.512 to comply with **Section 2**.

The fiscal impact of SB 250 on local government is expected to be minimal. The Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police states that most of the mandates required in SB 250, such as the written policy, should already be in place. The current policies may need to be modified some to verify compliance, which may incur some administrative costs.

The Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police did voice concern over the provisional requirements for the use of "Certified Mail" for return service by the officer. They stated that additional provisions are needed for service by the E-Warrant Service (Electronic Warrant System) that many departments now use.

The Kentucky Fraternal Order of Police was contacted for input. As of the submission of this Local Mandate Statement, a response has not been received from the organization. When a response is received, the statement may be updated accordingly.
