Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

This bill adds the chief of police of the Bowling Green Police Department to the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council as an ex officio member with voting rights by reason of their office. This bill also changes the requirements for a quorum from ten members to a majority of the members.

The fiscal impact on the city of Bowling Green is expected to be neutral and minimal with the impact related to attendance of council meetings. Members of the council shall receive no salary but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the performance of their functions.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

Part II, above, pertains to SB 96 GA version of the bill. The GA version is the same as the bill introduced. No amendments or substitutes were adopted when the bill passed its chamber of origin.
