Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 317 amends KRS Chapter 67B to establish the powers, duties, code of conduct, and certain privileges for peace officers within the correctional services department of consolidated local governments

The fiscal impact of HB 317 on local governments is indeterminable. The bill only applies to Jefferson County, as it is the only consolidated local government in the Commonwealth, at this time.

The bill establishes a set of standards of professional conduct for peace officers in addition to a set of due process rights for peace officers in the event of allegations of misconduct by said peace officers and rights to paid or unpaid leave in the event that a peace officer is involved in a critical incident. Thus, it may be necessary to allocate resources to train relevant staff on these new standards, although the exact amount needed is unknown.
