Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 516 creates a new section of KRS Chapter 210 to create the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline fund; establish authorized uses for fund; amends KRS 186.162 to add a specialized license plate for the national 988 suicide and crisis lifeline fund.

The fiscal impact of HB 516 on local government is indeterminable, but expected to be minimal.

No projections for the estimated number of special license plates are provided. However, an assumption is made that this new plate will not generate new or additional license plates, but rather, that existing plates will be exchanged for the new specialized plates and initial specialized plates will be purchased instead of any other plate. Since the county clerk shall retain the same amount of the registration fee for a regular license plate, as it does for special license plates, at initial issuance and renewal, there is minimal fiscal impact of this bill.

Part III: Differences to Local Government Mandate Statement from Prior Versions

The analysis presented above in Part II is based on HB 516 as introduced. No other versions exist for comparison.
