Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 531 amends KRS 83A.130, 83A.140, and 83A.150 to require that for each regular meeting of a city's legislative body, an agenda shall be prepared and distributed to members at least 72 hours prior to the meeting, and the agenda shall be made available to members of the public at the time of the meeting.

The fiscal impact of HB 531 is expected to be minimal. Minor administrative and/or printing costs may be associated with providing agendas to legislative body members and the public.
