## Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

SB 275 creates a new section of KRS Chapter 19A to establish the Kentucky all-payer claims database. In part, the bill requires the executive director of the Office of Data Analytics to develop, implement, operate, and maintain the database.

Neither the Kentucky Association of Counties (KACo) nor the Kentucky League of Cities (KLC) keeps a comprehensive list of counties or cities that self-insure for health insurance. KACo officials stated they were aware of the following counties that self-insure, but noted that there could be more: Boone, Boyle, Grant, Henderson, Jessamine, Lincoln, Logan, and Scott. KLC staff identified the following cities as self-insured: Benton, Corbin, Hopkinsville, Madisonville, Paducah, Winchester, Ashland, Independence, and Shelbyville.

**SB 275 would have minimal fiscal impact on local governments** that opt for a self-insured health plan because they would be responsible for meeting the reporting

requirements in Section 6(4) of the bill and in doing so, would incur some administrative costs.
