<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: This measure amends KRS 29A.170 to increase juror pay from \$5 to \$25 per day and removes language that provides jurors reimbursed expenses.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The enacted budget bill set juror pay at \$7.50 per day. An increase to \$25 per day with removing the reimbursed expenses would require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$3,600,000 each fiscal year. This estimate is based on current annual totals and may differ based on an increase or decrease in paid juror days for future fiscal years.
