**PURPOSE OF MEASURE:** House Bill 267 would authorize the Office of Broadband Development, an office within the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA), to utilize federal funds as part of the Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD) Program. The office would develop and submit Kentucky BEAD Grant Program funding requests to applicable federal entities; conduct a challenge process to identify locations eligible for funding; develop an application process and determine eligibility for prospective subgrantees; create rules for the review process and timelines for grant applications and challenges to said applications; evaluate subgrantee letters of credit, bonds, or other information to evaluate likelihood of project completion; coordinate with local entities; and oversee reporting and compliance consistent with federal laws.

This measure also establishes the BEAD fund in the State Treasury to be a trust and agency account. All moneys in the fund shall be allocated solely to providing moneys to grantees meeting federal requirements.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** While House Bill 267 makes an authorization and gives instruction for the use of federal funds through the BEAD Program, there is an indeterminable fiscal impact to the Office of Broadband Deployment in personnel and operating costs since the measure does not provide an appropriation to the BEAD fund. The Office of Broadband Deployment would need additional staff to administer the BEAD Program. The costs would depend on the caseload for the program.
