Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government
HB 425 proposes to allow cities and counties to create a children's early learning services taxing district for the purpose of financing and administering early learning services to children. If created, the district would impose a special ad valorem tax for the maintenance and operation of the district. The tax may be imposed at a rate that does not exceed 10¢ per each \$100 of the assessed valuation of all property in the district. If the district consists of more than just a single city, then the sheriff will collect the special ad valorem tax and be entitled to a fee of four percent of the tax collected.
There is no way to predict if cities or counties will choose to create a children's early learning district. Therefore, the fiscal impact of HB 425 is indeterminable.
