



A contest to stop arm camera violation shall be heard by the District Court, and the legislative body of the county shall direct the county attorney to defend the stop arm camera violation.

**The fiscal impact to county government is not determinable, expected to be positive but not significant.** According to data from the Administrative Office of the Courts for fiscal year 2023, local law enforcement issued 361 citations for violation of KRS 189.370, which resulted in 151 convictions. Participating local governments may see a slight increase in revenue due to receiving the civil penalty revenue for stop arm camera violations less any court costs and fees to sheriff's offices. Likewise for sheriff's offices.
