Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government
This bill adds the chief of police of the Owensboro Police Department and the director of the Northern Kentucky Police and Sheriff's Training Center to the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council as an ex officio member with voting rights.
The fiscal impact on the Owensboro police department is expected to be minimal with the impact related to attendance of council meetings. Members of the council shall receive no salary but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary expenses actually incurred in the performance of their functions. While attending meetings, Owensboro's Police Department may need to shift personnel to cover for the chief of police's absence.
