<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: The purpose of this measure is to prevent a pharmaceutical manufacturer participating in Medicaid from engaging in price discrimination.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** HB490 allows the Office of the Attorney General to investigate complaints of price discrimination against pharmaceutical manufacturers. It would likely require an additional attorney, paralegal, and investigator. The estimated fiscal impact is \$450,000 annually for salary and operating costs.
