PURPOSE OF MEASURE: The measure modifies the career and technical education (CTE) supplemental funding distribution by replacing the existing funding calculation for locally-operated programs and expanding uses to include state-operated centers beginning in fiscal year 2025. The measure requires both locally- and state-operated programs and centers to maintain eligibility for federal funding in order to receive supplemental funding and permits local districts to request their allocation of funding be used for students using CTE programs in grades five through eight. The measure also creates the CTE innovation and support fund, from which operating funds from the four state-operated centers that converted to local control and other funds received will have a modified distribution beginning in fiscal year 2025. The measure otherwise creates new definitions and requires promulgation of the necessary administrative regulations.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The measure changes the funding distribution of General Fund appropriations made by the General Assembly in the Department of Education's Learning and Results Services appropriation unit and does not have a fiscal impact.

House Floor Amendment 2 provides a one-time payment for state increments for state-operated Area Technology Center employees that converted to local control from the SEEK appropriation unit in the amount of \$170,000 in fiscal year 2024.
