Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government
BR 1820 amends KRS 186.162 to create an EMS special license plate. There would be an initial issuance fee of \$31 and a renewal fee of \$18 for the plate. The county clerk would retain \$6 for each initial or renewal plate, the same amount as a regular license plate assuance and renewal.
No projections for the estimated number of EMS special license plates are provided. An assumption is made that this legislation will not generate new registrations and license plates, but rather, that existing registrations will be exchanged for new personalized plates.
Since the county clerk retains the same fee for a regular license plate as it does for an EMS special license plate, there is minimal fiscal impact of this bill.
