**PURPOSE OF MEASURE:** HB 603 modifies KRS 186.531(3) to eliminate the fee for personal identification cards (no fixed address) from the current five dollars (\$5) fee.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** The fee for an identification card with no fixed address is directed to the KYTC photo license account, a part of the road fund. It is estimated that one thousand eight hundred (1,800) cards are produced annually. Eliminating this fee will cause an annual negative revenue impact of \$9,000.
