PURPOSE OF MEASURE: The legislation creates the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline fund, adds a specialized license plate for the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline fund, and directs that any gifts, grants, contributions, appropriations, or fees collected from sales of the specialized license plate be deposited into the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline fund.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS, Cabinet) estimates that the legislation would have an unknown revenue impact on the Cabinet as the number of specialized license plate sales cannot be forecasted with certainty, nor could any future grants, gifts, contributions, or appropriations. There would be minimal costs involved in the production of the license plates and staff administrative costs for CHFS.
