Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 740 establishes a 988 suicide and crisis lifeline special license plate. \$6 of each initial and renewal plate will go to the county clerks.

No projections for the estimated number of 988 suicide and crisis lifeline special license plates are provided. An assumption is made that this legislation will not generate new registrations and license plates, but rather, that existing registrations will be exchanged for new personalized plates.

Since the county clerk retains the same fee for a regular license plate as it does for a 988 suicide and crisis lifeline special license plate, **there is minimal fiscal impact of this bill**.
