<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: This measure amends KRS 625.080, 625.041, 625.0405 and 620.100 to increase the maximum guardian ad litem fee from \$500 to \$600.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: On average, the Finance and Administrative Cabinet processes 27,200 payments annually under KRS 625.080, 625.041, 625.0405, and 620.100. Increasing the maximum guardian ad litem fee from \$500 to \$600 would result in a General Fund increase of \$2,720,000 in each fiscal year.
