Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government
HB 836 would amend KRS 67C.135 to require county clerks to mail voters a notice informing them of their current legislative council district and member upon the completion of reapportionment if legislative council district boundaries changed.
It would also amend KRS 116.085 to require county clerks to mail voters a notice informing them of their current district number, State Representative, and State Senator upon the enactment of a new redistricting plan.
The negative fiscal impact of HB 836 on county clerks would be limited to the cost of postage for mailing these notices to voters when reapportionment or redistricting occurs.
