## Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 84 deletes language from KRS 186.174(4)(b) that adds additional fees to the costs of purchasing a personalized license plate, beyond the standard \$43 cost required under KRS 186.162(2)(m) and the \$3 fee required by KRS 186.040(6).

## The fiscal impact of HB 84 on local governments will be nil; no impact.

The passage of HB 498 during the 2022 Regular Session had the unintended consequence of some county clerks charging more than the standard \$46 for personalized license plates. Anyone who overpaid is due a refund, which will be provided by the Transportation Cabinet and come out of the road fund.
