



**Section 4** would amend KRS 116.113 to provide that the county clerk is responsible for removing a registered voter's name when necessary.

**The fiscal impact of SB 108 on county clerks is expected to be negative.** According to the Kentucky County Clerks Association, there would be significant programming costs associated with changing the voter registration system from a top-down design to a bottom-up system. It is unclear who would be responsible for the cost of the system change.

There would be mailing costs associated with Section 3 that are currently paid for by the State Board of Elections. Additional county clerk office personnel would be necessary to carry out the new duties of the bill and training would likely be required. It is anticipated that the cost of most of the bill's provisions would be the responsibility of the county clerks.
