Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

Section 21 of SB 199 HCS 1 amends KRS 186.060 to require that applications for the registration of motor vehicles leased or owned by a governmental unit, be entered into AVIS by the county clerk. It is unknown if this will lead to increased administrative costs to the county clerk.

Section 23 of SB 199 HCS 1 sets a fee of \$40 for the reinstatement of a suspended or revoked registration. Of which, the county clerk shall retain \$20.

Section 24 of SB 199 HCS 1 allows the county clerk to retain \$1 of the fees from the registration of electric vehicles, electric motorcycles, and hybrid vehicles imposed in KRS 138.475.

The fiscal impact of SB 199 HCS 1 is indeterminable, but expected to be positive due to the money received from the reinstatement fee in Section 23 and the electric and hybrid vehicle/motorcycle fees in Section 24.

The Transportation Cabinet has been asked to provide data related to SB 199/HCS. This local mandate will be updated once the requested information has been received.
