**Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government**

Section 21 of SB 199/GA amends KRS 186.060 to require that applications for the registration of motor vehicles leased or owned by a governmental unit, be entered into AVIS by the county clerk. It is unknown if this will lead to increased administrative costs to the county clerk.

Section 23 of SB 199/GA sets a fee of \$40 for the reinstatement of a suspended or revoked registration. Of which, the county clerk shall retain \$20.

Section 24 of SB 199/GA allows the county clerk to retain \$1 of the fees from the registration of electric vehicles, electric motorcycles, and hybrid vehicles imposed in KRS 138.475.

**The fiscal impact of SB 199/GA is indeterminable**, but expected to be positive due to the money received from the reinstatement fee in Section 23 and the electric and hybrid vehicle/motorcycle fees in Section 24.

The Transportation Cabinet has been asked to provide data related to SB 199/GA. This local mandate will be updated once the requested information has been received.
