**Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government**

SB 202 SCS 1 amends KRS 439.340 and KRS 533.030 to stipulate that a condition for parole, probation, or conditional discharge may include participation in an evidence-based program to reduce violence.

**The fiscal impact of SB 202 SCS 1 is indeterminable.** Postincarceration supervision is typically a duty of the Department of Corrections. However, “evidence-based program to reduce violence” is not clearly defined, so if such a program were funded by local government, then that program may see more participants as a result of the bill, which could require greater expenditures to manage it properly.
