<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: House Floor Amendment #3 to HB 1 retains the original provisions of the bill. Additionally, the amendment proposes to exclude from individual income tax all wages earned by a state service employee. A state service employee is defined to mean a person regularly appointed to a position in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of government for which he or she is compensated on a full-time, part-time, or interim basis, but does not include members of the General Assembly.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: To determine the fiscal impact of the amendment, staff used the current annualized amount of state payroll, totaling approximately \$2,298.5 billion for approximately 40,000 employees. Since the number of hours worked for the approximate 500 part-time employees is not known, those employees' wages were annualized and included in the total state service employee wages. Total wages were then increased by 3 percent to account for the budgeted raise for state employees on July 1, 2025. This payroll figure was then multiplied by the current 4 percent tax rate. Because the beginning of tax year 2026 aligns with only the second half of FY 2026, one-half a full year's impact is realized. The full implementation will be realized in FY 2027.
